2. La Gaillarde Long loved for its reworked vintage and located in a former department store, this depot teems with affordable tops and dresses

Surface Jalouse In the midst of a row of celebrated restaurants and musty treasure-laden antique stores, this brand-new, hyper-modern suite of rooms is all about home furnishings embellished with custom images (it's owned by two graphic designers and a professional printer).
