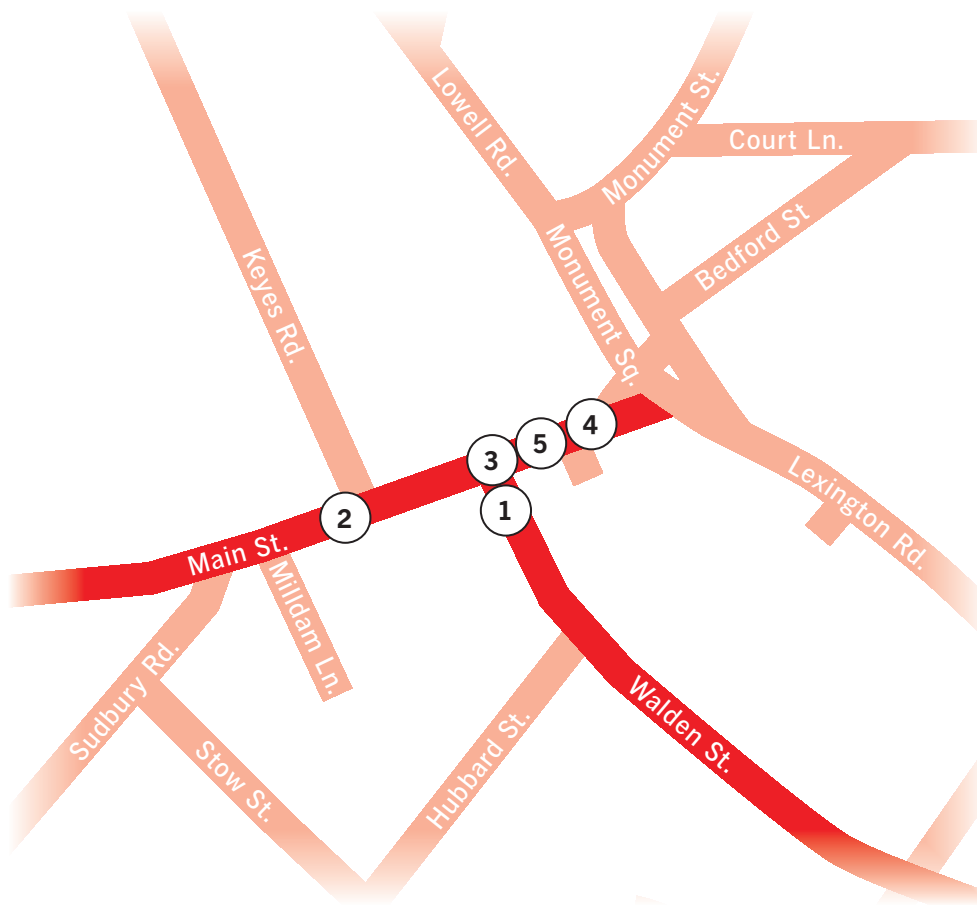


Concord
