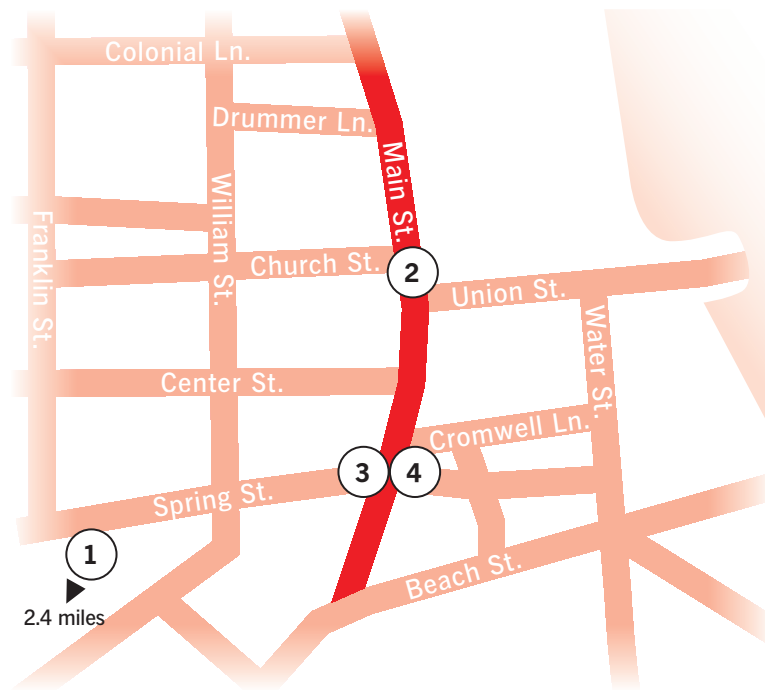


## Vineyard Haven, MA



- 1. Midnight Farm** Arguably the most hyped boutique in the region (Carly Simon is a partner), Midnight Farm brings a department-store-like depth to bohemian, folksy style. - 2. Mix** This 2005 arrival focuses on retro-themed home items, like brightly colored Fiesta ware and pitchers from the '60s. There's also a sizable selection of hostess-gift-appropriate loot, like picture frames and printed aprons. **4 Union St., 508-693-8240**
- 3. Nochi** Sticking to a pared-down palette of white, gray, and green, this unassuming flower shop/gift store is one of those spots that get better and better the closer you look.
